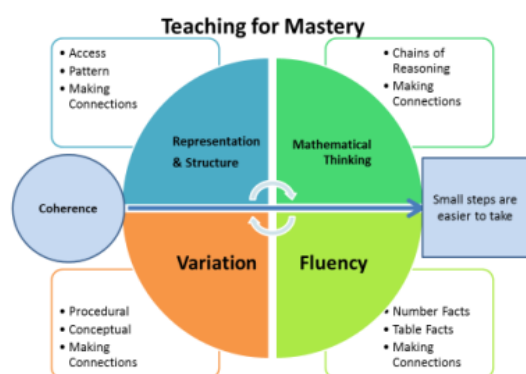


**Teaching for Mastery in Mathematics:
Sharing Great Practice – Keynote session by Dr Debbie Morgan,
NCETM Director for Primary Mathematics**

One of the most significant changes in education is currently taking place:
Teaching for Mastery in Mathematics.

The influence of Teaching for Mastery originates from high performing places such as Shanghai in China and recent additional government funding for further involvement in Teaching for Mastery signifies a long-term commitment to this development.

Attending this conference will enable you to grasp the key ideas behind the principles of teaching for mastery in mathematics as well as an appreciation of how one school has taken and developed this approach.

This conference will give participants a unique opportunity to hear from Dr Debbie Morgan, see excellent examples of Teaching for Mastery at Greenleas School and consider an approach towards teaching for Mastery. Sheila Quinn, Deputy Head Teacher and Mastery Specialist Teacher from Greenleas, will share the journey so far and you will be able to see Teaching for Mastery 'in action'. There will also be opportunity to reflect on the live lesson in the style of a TRG (teacher research group).

The conference will enable delegates to:

- Have a greater awareness of Teaching for Mastery,
- Hear the latest developments in Teaching for Mastery from Dr Debbie Morgan talking about problem solving within the context of teaching for mastery, planning in small steps and Early Years,
- See first-hand how Greenleas School is implementing a Teaching for Mastery approach to mathematics,
- Participate in a Teacher Research Group to unpick and discuss strategies and approaches observed,
- Learn about similarities and differences from maths learning in Shanghai,
- Consider aspects when reviewing published materials / textbooks to use.
