Course aims:

- allow students to attempt problems both in groups and on their own
- get students thinking about writing and presenting their solutions to problems
- give students a chance to explore areas of maths not in the standard curriculum
- give students a chance to look at questions from STEP, AEA, TMUA and the MAT examinations

Course fees and application:

Places are limited and we expect students to commit to the whole course. Tuition is subsidised for students at state schools so the fee for the whole course is just £25 per student. Fees are due after students have attended the first 2 sessions. Payment is online, by card. Students at small independent schools, meeting the criteria of having few students working at this level, are welcome at an unsubsidised fee of £260 subject to space being available.
