Pupils can attempt these independently or with their peers or anyone else in the home!

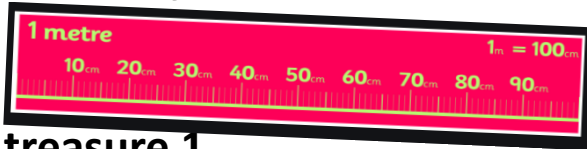
Do talk about and discuss the mathematics – Maths is real-life and fun!
